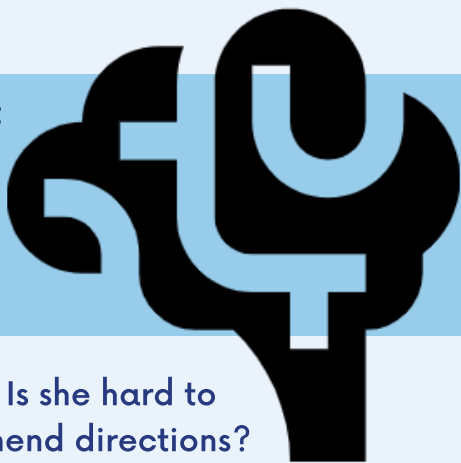


# GETTING YOUR CHILD EVALUATED FOR SPEECH & LANGUAGE DELAY AT SCHOOL

Submit your request for a speech/language evaluation in writing to the principal or school administrator.

The Permission to Evaluate- Evaluation Request Form will be sent home to you. Sign this form to show you agree to the evaluation.

Give your parent/guardian input when it's requested. You will get a form sent home and/or via email asking about your concerns.



Try to be specific with your input. Is she hard to understand? Does he not comprehend directions? Do you hear grammar mistakes that seem odd for her age or grade?

Wait 60 calendar days (this includes days there are no school) for the Evaluation to be completed.

Attend the meeting to go over the Evaluation Results.
